



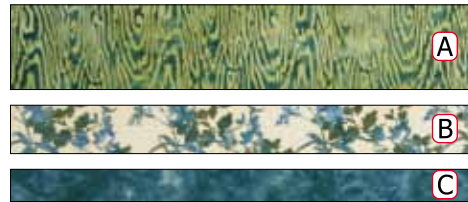
Mini Ten Table Topper

Ten Degree Wedge Tips

- The ten degree mini wedge tool makes a 25 inch circle when 36 wedges are sewn together with exact 1/4" seams. Seam allowances are included with the tool.
- The center opening is 5 1/2".
- For angled wedge designs, the 45 degree markings can be drawn onto the tool, tracing from the front cover of the mini ten packaging.
- If clear packaging tape is applied as suggested below, be sure to remove it after use.



Cutting		
A	8 strips	3" x width
B	8 strips	2" x width
C	4 strips	1" x width



Yardage	
A	3/4 yd
B	1/2 yd
C	1/4 yd
Center	7" sq
Backing	3/4 yd
Batting	26" x 26"
Binding	1/3 yd

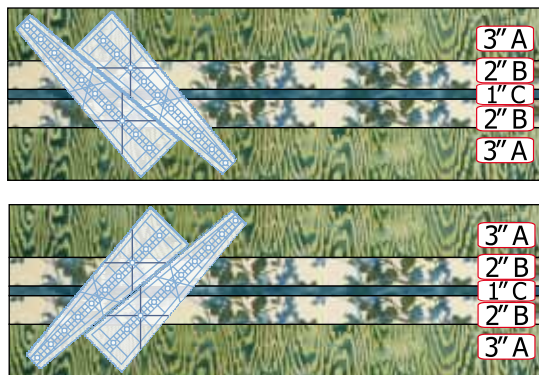
Sewing Strips

Sew a strip set (A-B-C-B-A), sewing with exact 1/4" seams. Press the strip set. Sew **four** identical strip sets.

Make two of each strip set

Place the 45 degree line 1/2" below the the B-A line. Draw the line onto the tool for accuracy.

Cut 18 wedges angled left and 18 wedges angled right



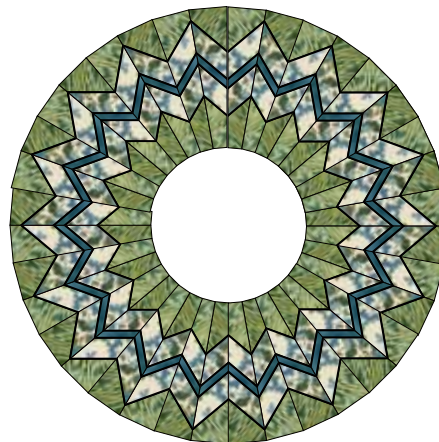
Cut 18 wedges of each

Cutting Wedges

Place a tube of wide transparent tape, sticky side out along the entire length of the 10 degree wedge. This will keep your wedge from slipping.

Sewing Wedges

Place two wedges together, right sides facing.
Sew the wedges together, being cautious not to stretch the bias edges.
Sew exact 1/4" seams.
Sew wedges into pairs, then into fours, etc. until a circle of 36 wedges is formed.
Press the circle with seam allowances going in one direction.



Center Applique for Table Topper

Applique a 6" circle over the center opening using your favorite applique technique. More detailed information is available on the website.
Quilt and bind as desired.
