

## Rings That Bind Supply List

Class project: a two block wall hanging /table runner

To complete a wall hanging in a one day workshop, you will need to have your pieces pre-cut. If in doubt about any step, no problem, we'll take care of it in class. Books are available by calling 874-8680 or at the next meeting.

### Pre-Cutting List

Pre Wash and Iron your fabric before cutting

Cut the following pieces:

Background Fabric .....1 yd

Two 17 ½” circles (use Arc-Ease Tool following page 10)

Be sure you measure the 8 ¾” carefully

Six scallop pieces (use Arc-Ease Tool following page 11)

Note you're cutting only on the top edge of the arc tool  
and on the fold of the fabric.

Interior Square Fabric.....3/8 yd

Two 12 ½” squares

Ring Fabric A\* .....3/8 yd

Seven arc pieces (use Arc-Ease Tool following page 12)

Ring Fabric B\* .....3/8 yd

Seven arc pieces (use Arc-Ease Tool following page 12)

Batting

Here is a list of what you'll need, but I have enough

batting squares donated from Hobbs for everyone.

You're welcome to use it in class.

Two 11 ½” squares (cotton batting only see page 11)

Six scallop pieces (use Arc-Ease Tool following page 11)

Note you're cutting only one layer

And only on the top edge of the arc tool

Note: You may choose to use only one ring color.

If so, cut 14 arcs.

### Supplies

Book: Rings That Bind with Arc-Ease Tool

Pencil or fabric marker, chalk if dark fabric

Rotary cutter

Mat

Sewing Machine

¼ presser foot for machine

Iron

Ironing board

Thread for piecing

Thread for top stitching (to match ring colors or can be monofilament)

Stylus (optional)

Pins- long and strong

Hand Sewing Needle
